

2015 ACTISA EXHIBITION GALA

The ACTISA exhibition gala for 2015 will be held on Saturday 12th December from 4pm. It's time to get those creative thinking caps on.

We are hoping to encourage skaters to think about trying a group skate with a friend or two friends or even more...(although no one will be prevented from doing a solo skate of course).

To this end **we have organised a little extra ice time to be available exclusively for the purpose of practicing group routines away from usual lesson times. Group practice ice will be available from 530 to 630pm each Tuesday for 7 weeks from Tuesday 27th October to Tuesday 8th December inclusive.** The cost for the session will be collected by rink management as per usual and will not be included in monthly passes. However we are very grateful to rink management for agreeing to make this extra session available.

In return we will ask that all skaters remember that during regular figure skating sessions the ice is used for several purposes including ice dance, skaters preparing for National Championships (till at least 1st December) and others having private lessons so exemplary skating etiquette needs to apply over coming weeks. Please be guided by your coaches as to correct etiquette to avoid upsetting other skaters. Coaches as always have first right of use of the music machine for skaters in a lesson and we would need to ask that morning sessions should not be used to practice or choreograph group routines until after Nationals.

Skaters please talk to your coaches (and friends) about what you plan to do and what assistance you might need from them. You will choose your own music but in order to encourage variety it would be good if you can ask your coach to put your music choice on the list in the coaches room for everyone's information.

We want everyone to have fun so we can celebrate the end of our skating year in style.

We will be keeping entry costs very low to cover costs only.
