For Aussie Skate (AS) levels please use AS-level for Division-Program

For example: AS-Intermediate-DanielSmith

For Artistic Competitors please use ARTISTIC-Div3-RubySmith

One file should be submitted per skating program.

All competitors must **also have a backup** of their competition music available on an audio quality CD. The CD must contain only ONE track, and must be marked with the:

- Competitor's Name
- Competition Division, e.g. 'Division 4: Preliminary'
- Program Identification, e.g. 'Artistic Program'
- · Running time of music (NOT skating time)

All submitted music files will be deleted at the end of the competition.
