Each program (short program, free skating, short dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music. Two (2) files may be submitted on USB drive as specified by the OC.
The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of the event. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.

ACT Championship perpetual trophy presented to each division. Only ACT competitors are eligible for the title of ACT Champion and the perpetual trophy.
