(Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their ISA Member). The membership must be valid during the full competition period. All Aussie Skate™ entrants must also be registered with ISA Aussie Skate [™] and currently enrolled in Aussie Skate [™] Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.
